3.		To approve the minutes of the last meeting: Minutes of the last meeting (27.04.26) were deferred for approval until the next scheduled Finance & Monitoring Committee.
4.		To approve awarding a greening contract to Antur Waunfawr / Cyngor Gwynedd, totaling £8,000: The Committee was presented with three quotes for the greening contract. Two quotations were received from horticultural organisations and the third quotation was received from Cyngor Gwynedd Council's Learning Disability team, who offered a greening service that provided meaningful employment opportunities for vulnerable adults from Bangor to undertake this work, in a supervised environment. • Councillors were satisfied that the necessary procedures had been followed to procure this contract. • Councillors were satisfied that the quotation provided by Cyngor Gwynedd Council represented value for money. • Councillors expressed the need for a formal 'greening' specification to be produced by officers, in advance of procuring this service in the next

municipal year in order that it can be approved by Full Council prior to entering the procurement phase.

- To note that additional costs may be incurred should extra watering be required due to exceptionally warm weather.
